

This graph illustrates the increments between current supply and what is projected for 2060. Look at Region C. The “identified need” is about 1.6 million AFY. The “recommended” supply to be developed is about 2.3 million AFY. In short, Region C recommends building 700,000 AFY more supply than the identified need. The 700,000 AFY difference is about the same amount as the three proposed new reservoirs would yield. In short, identified needs could be met *without* new reservoirs.

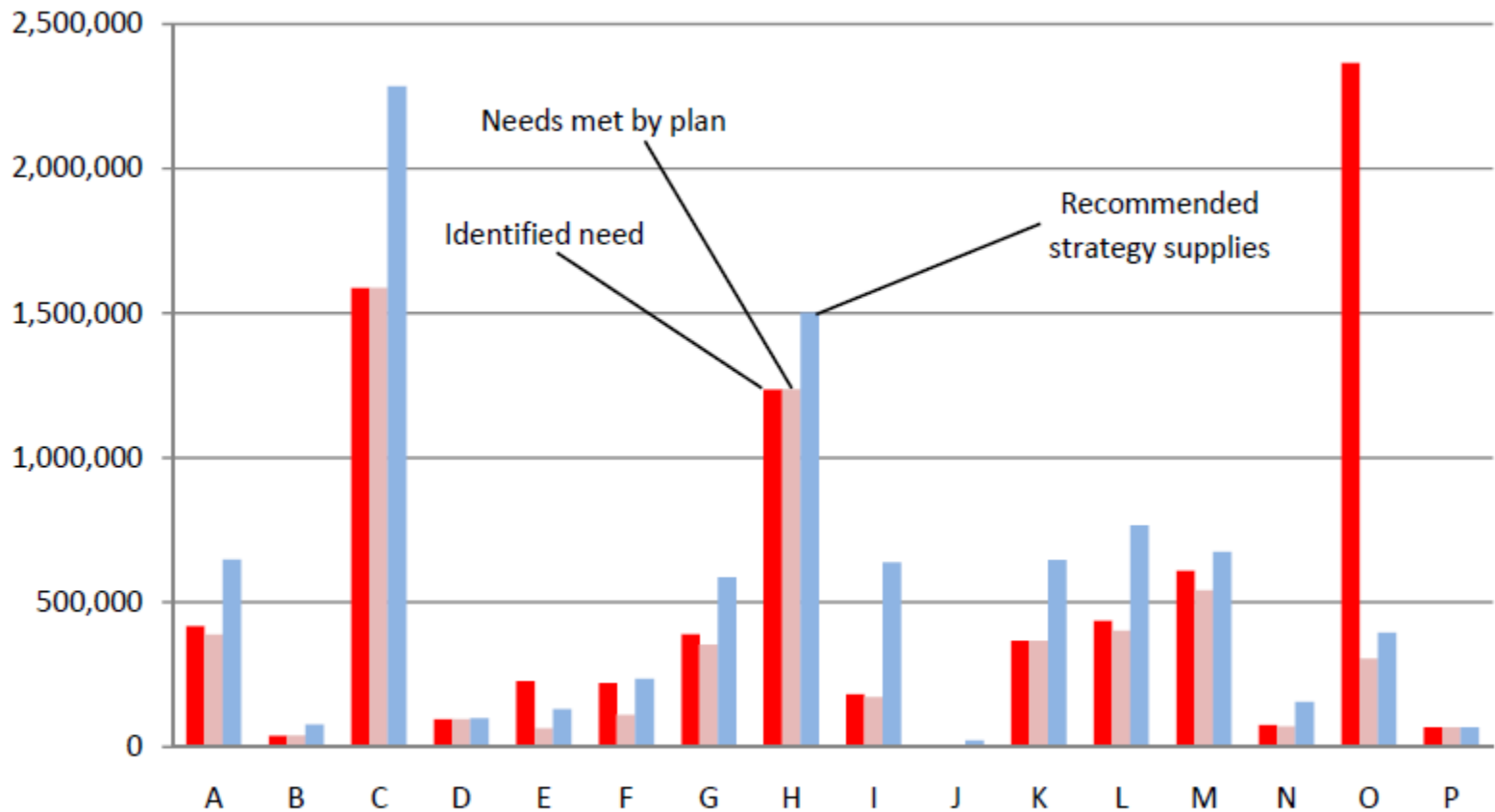


Figure 2.7 – 2060 Water Needs, Needs Met by Plans, and Strategy Supply – by Region (acre-feet/year)
